

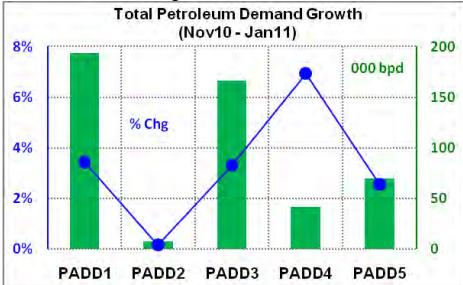


Wholesale Petroleum Demand

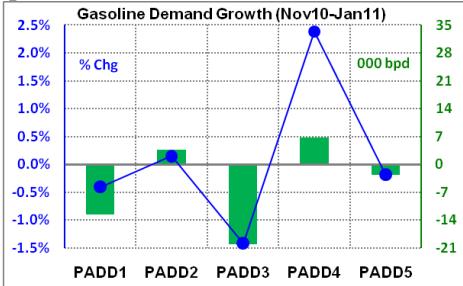
Wholesale demand for all petroleum products, including finished and unfinished products increased +478,000 bpd over the prior year for the November 2010 through January 2011 quarter, a +2.5% increase.

The -6.9% drop in propane, and -0.3% decline in gasoline limited energy demand year-on-year growth in the Nov10 - Jan11 quarter. Demand in PADDs 1, 3 and 5 grew greater than +2.5% while PADD 1 increased only +0.2% for the period.



Gasoline wholesale demand decreased -26,000 bpd over the prior year for the November 2010 through January 2011 quarter, a -0.3% decrease.

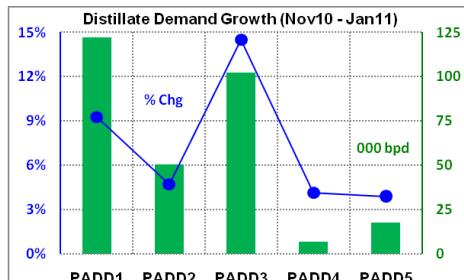


Demand was lower in most major regions with declines of -1.4% to -0.2% in PADDs 1, 3 and 5. Demand was nearly unchanged in PADD 2 while increasing +2.4% in PADD 04.

Distillate wholesale demand increased +300,000 bpd over the prior year for the November 2010 through January 2011 quarter, a +8.1% increase.

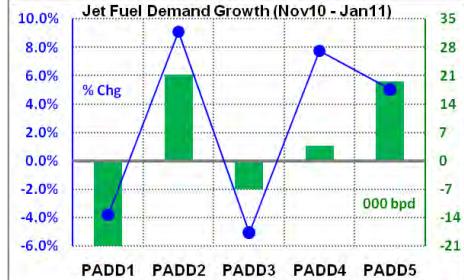

Demand climbed +9.3% in PADD 01 and +4.7% in PADD 02. Demand in PADD 03 exceeded levels of the prior 5-years on economic growth in that region. Demand in all other regions was below historic highs, with PADD 05 significantly lower.

Demand in PADD 03 jumped +14.5% on a spike in December 2010. Jet fuel wholesale demand increased +15,000 bpd over the prior year for the November 2010 through January 2011 quarter, a +1.1% increase.



Demand climbed +21,000 and +20,000 bpd in PADDs 02 and 05; respectively.

Demand in PADD 01 decreased -21,000 bpd, with PADDs 03 and 04 nearly unchanged.

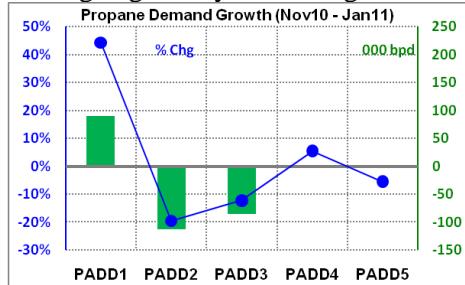
Residual fuel oil wholesale demand increased +57,000 bpd over the prior year for the November 2010 through January 2011 quarter, a +10.3% increase.

Demand increased +25,000 bpd in PADD 03 and +21,000 bpd in PADD 01 for the quarter. Demand in other regions was flat for the period.

Propane wholesale demand decreased -110,000 bpd over the prior year for the November 2010 through January 2011 quarter, a -6.9% decline.

Reduced use for grain drying in the Midwest and petrochemicals in the Gulf drove the drop in demand. Demand fell -113,000 bpd in PADD 02 and -85,000 bpd in PADD 03 for the

quarter. These declines were partially offset by a +90,000 bpd increase in PADD 01 demand on above normal heating degree days in the region.

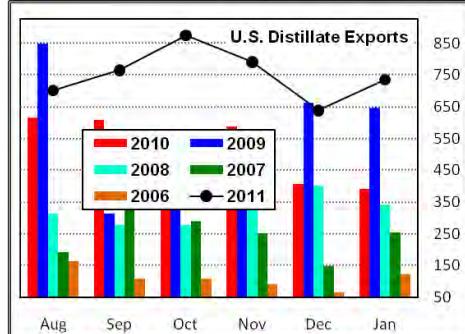


Petroleum Product Exports

Exports of refined fuels were significantly above the prior year for all fuels.

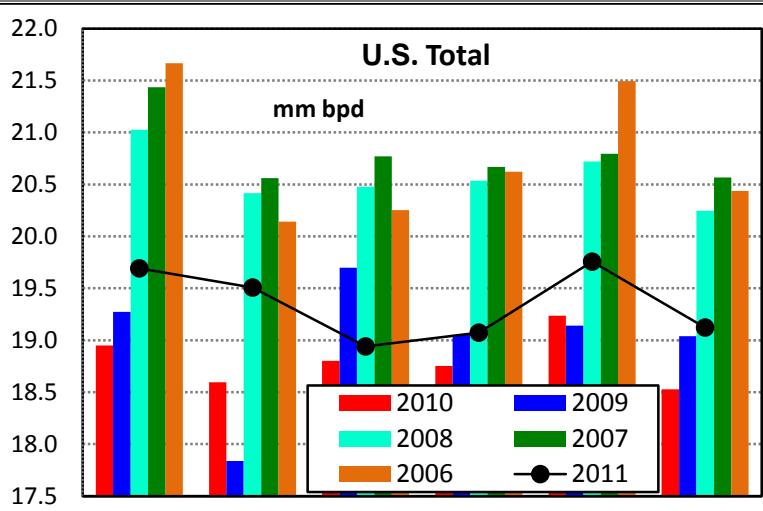

Gasoline exports averaged 448,000 bpd in the November 2010 to January 2011 quarter, an +87% year-on-year increase. Distillate exports averaged 721,000 bpd for the quarter, a +56% increase. Jet fuel, residual fuel oil and propane exports increased +20%, +15% and +9.4%; respectively.



Combined exports of the 5-major fuels were +1.9 million bpd during the month of January 2011. This was a +710,000 bpd (+60%) increase over last year. The surge in exports reflects robust economic growth among Central and South American countries, and the closure of refineries in the Caribbean and Europe during the recession.

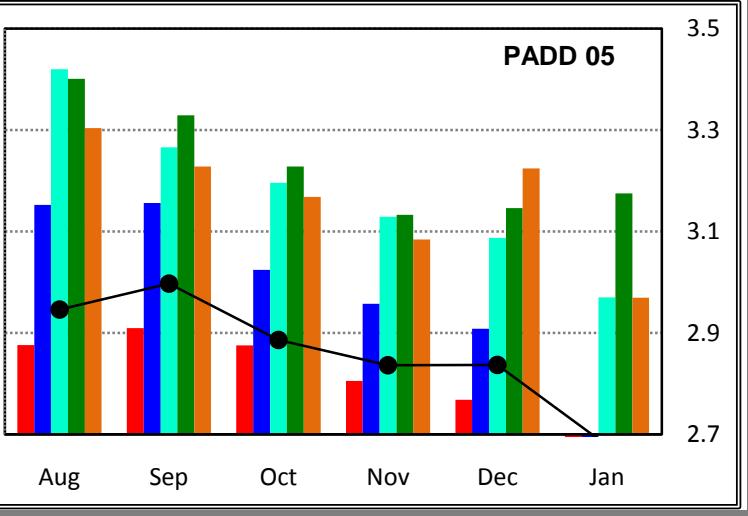
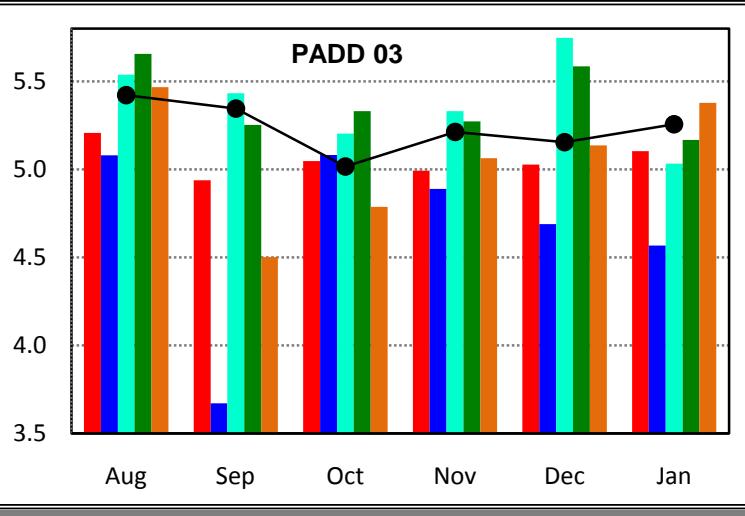
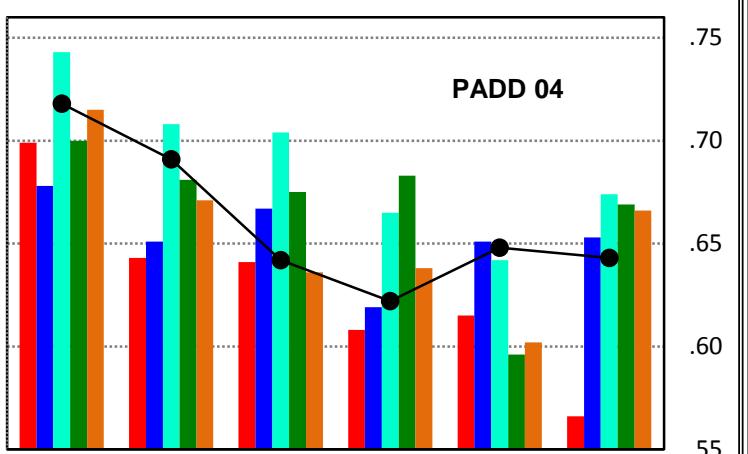
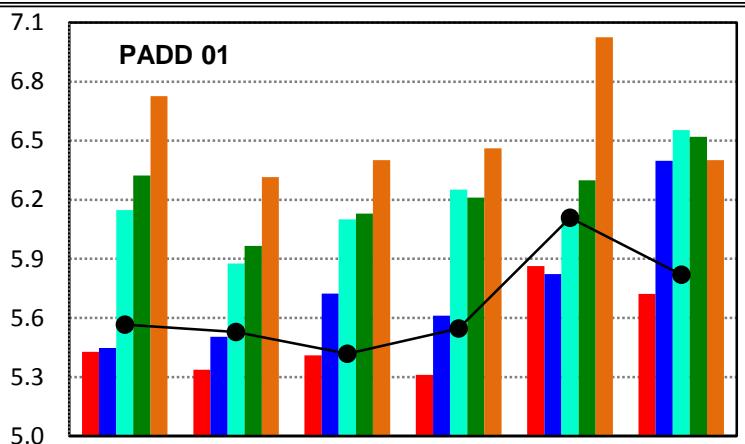
Total Petroleum Demand

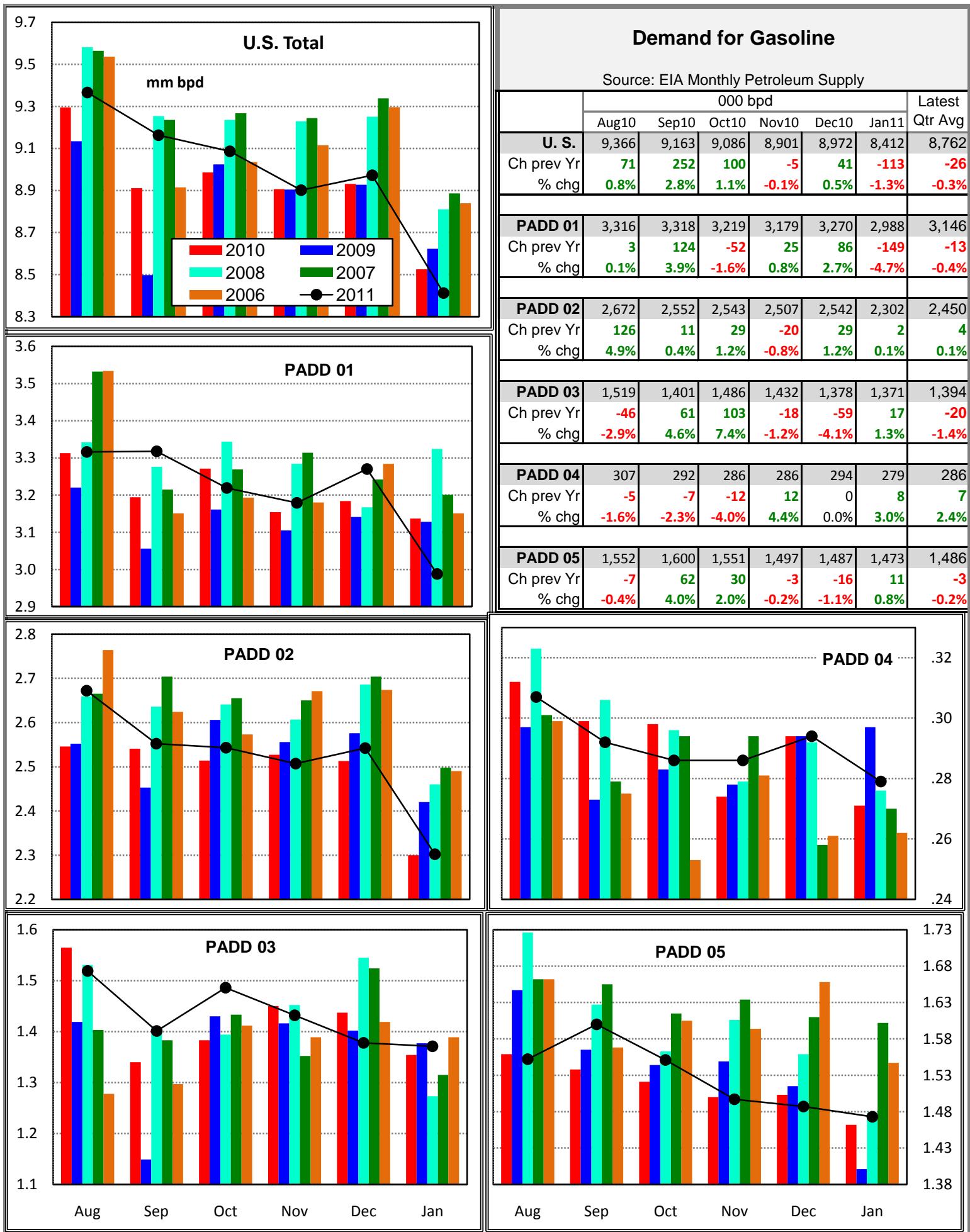


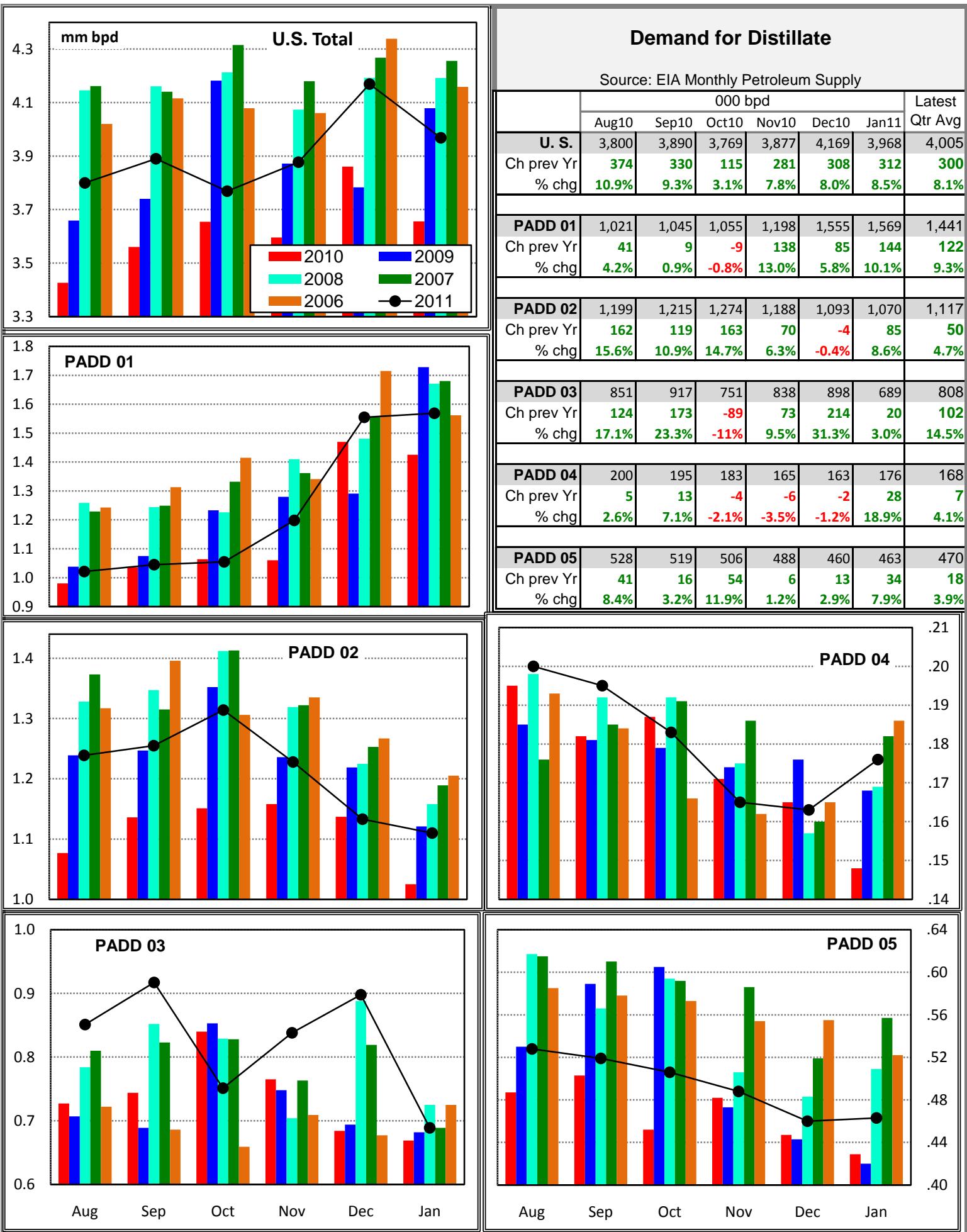
Demand for all Petroleum Products

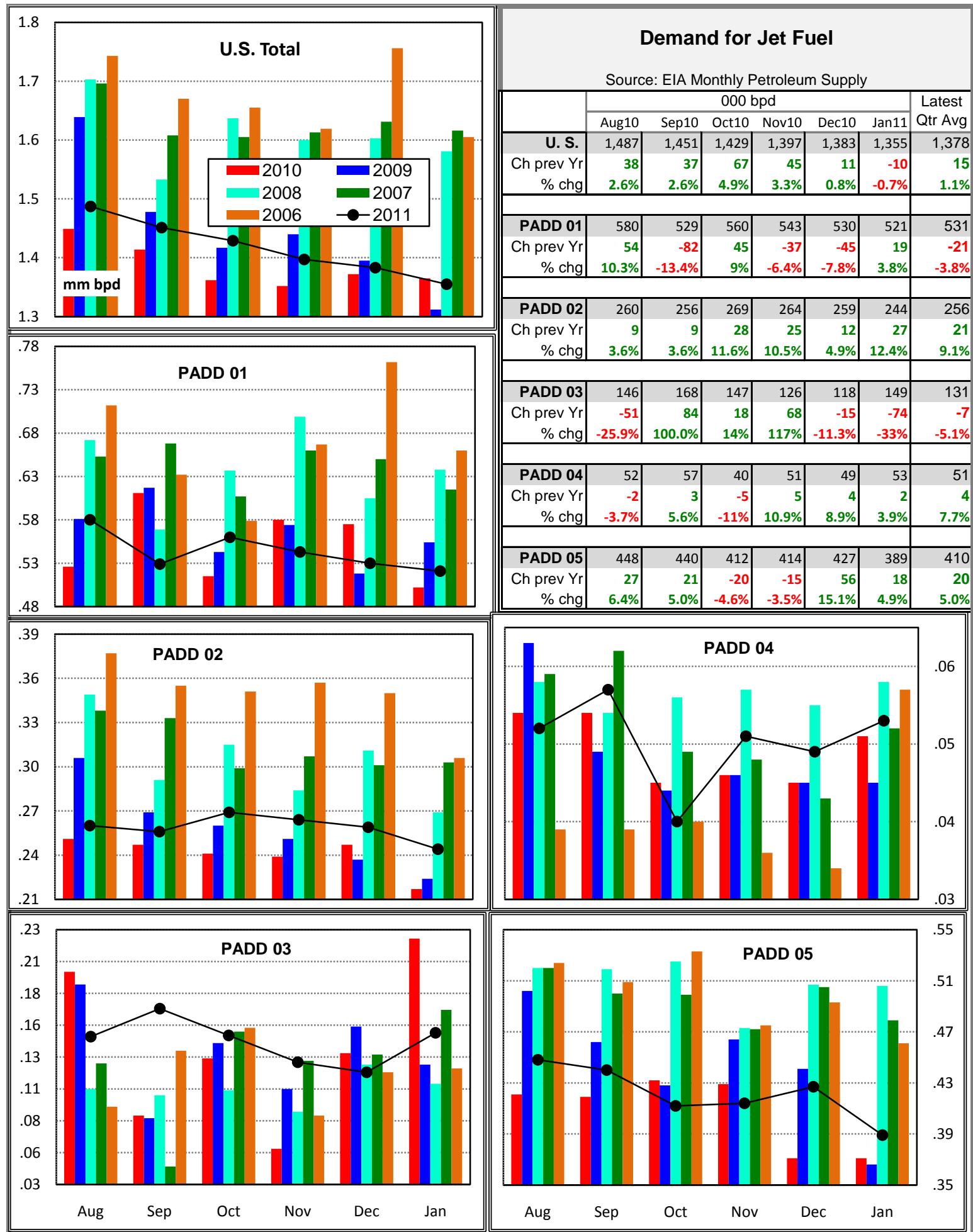

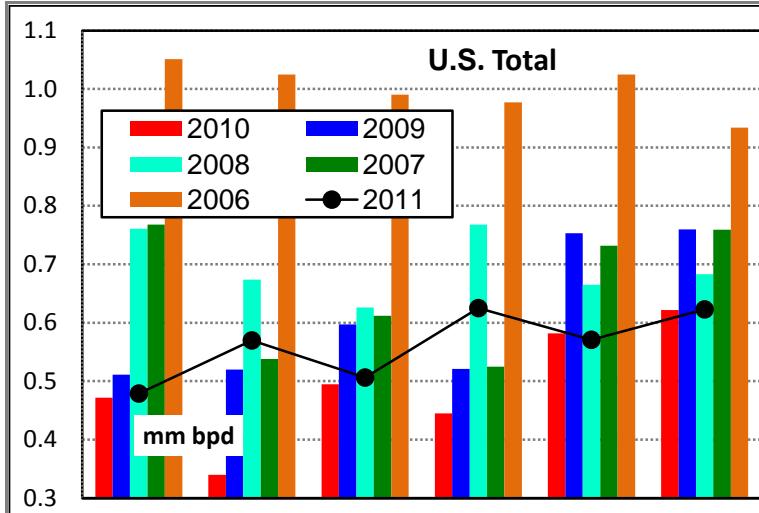
Gasoline Demand

Jet Fuel Demand



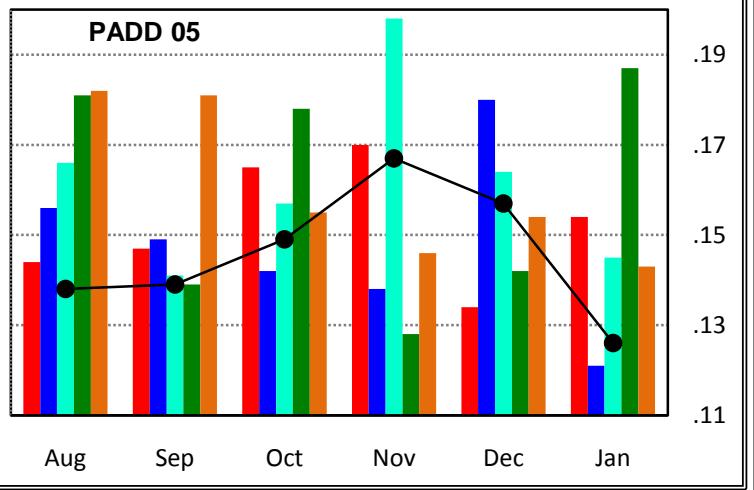
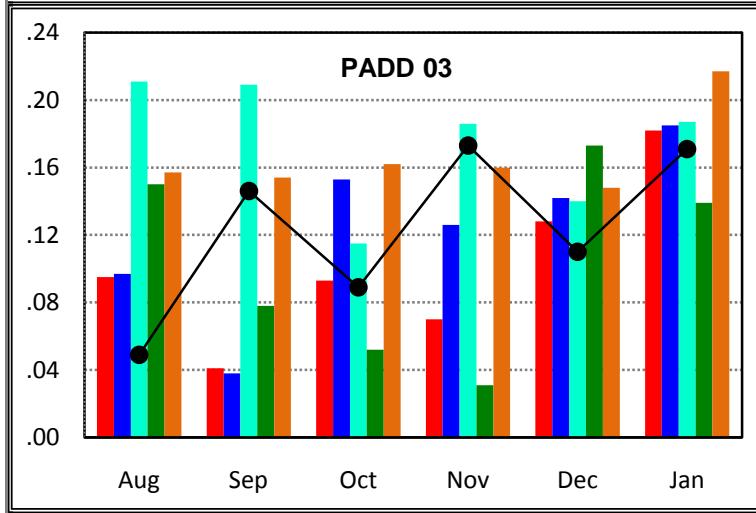
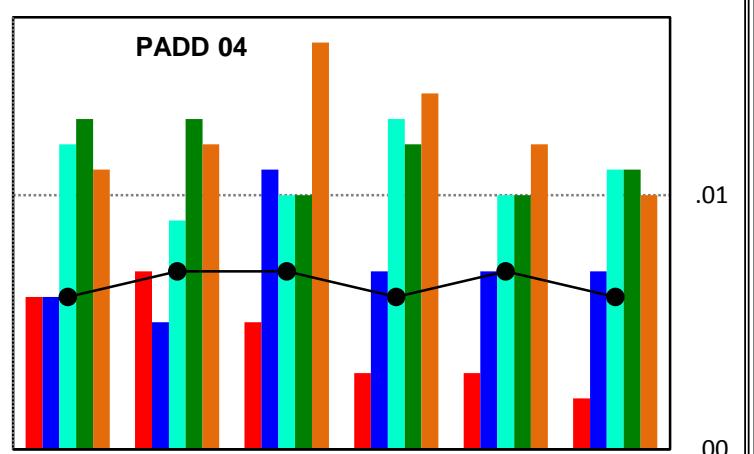
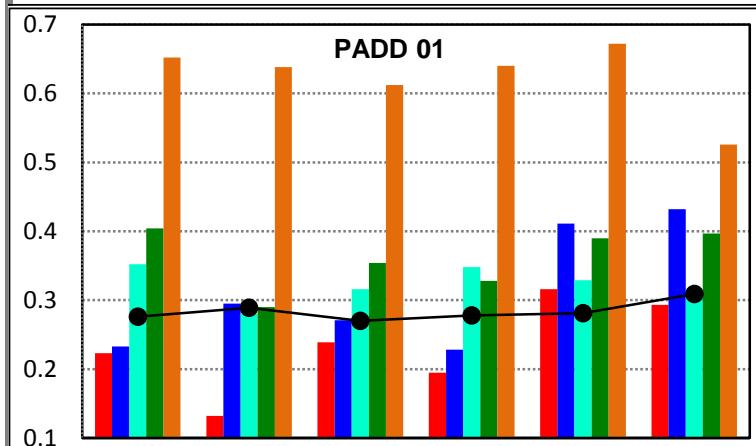
Residual Fuel Demand



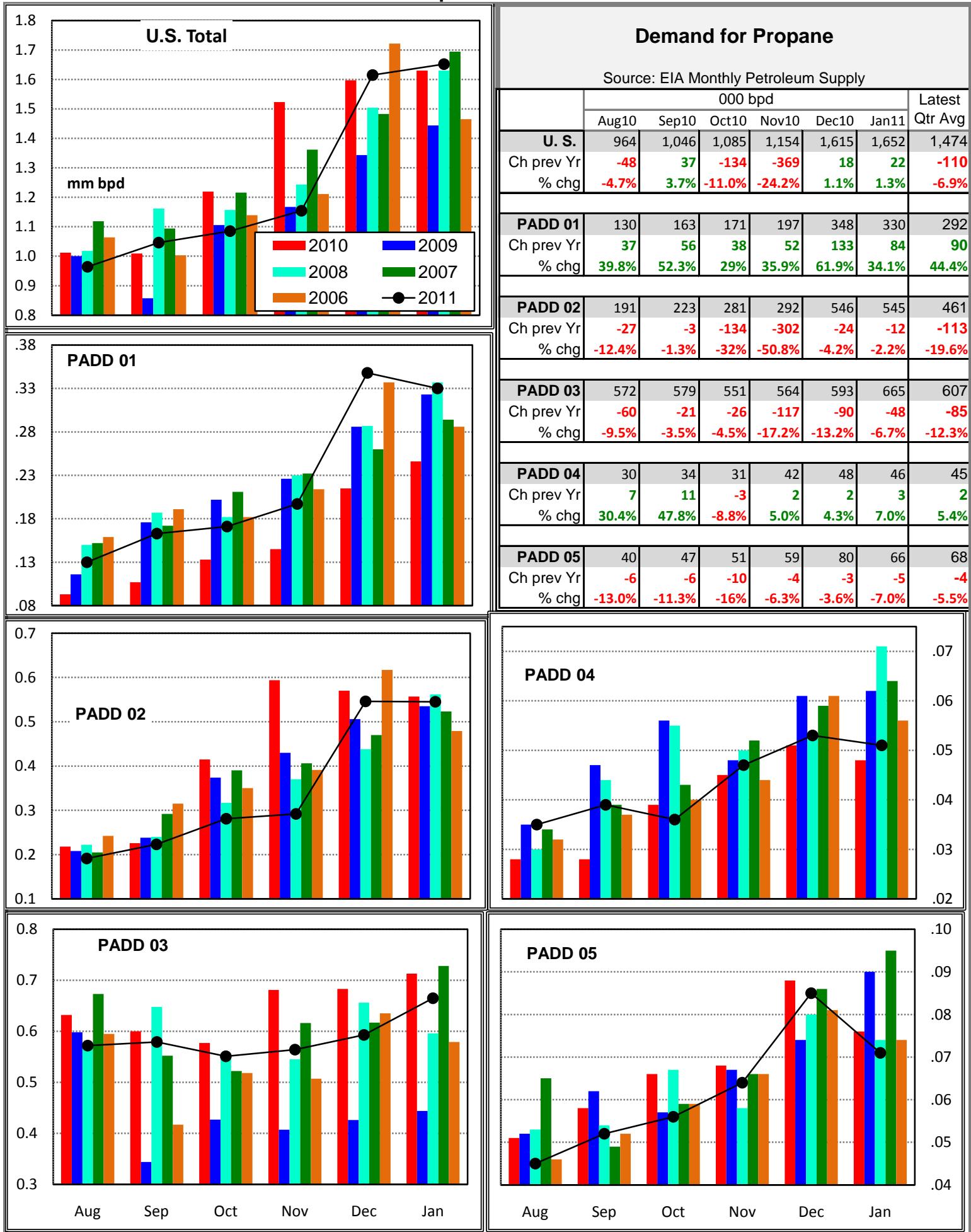
Demand for Residual Fuel Oil

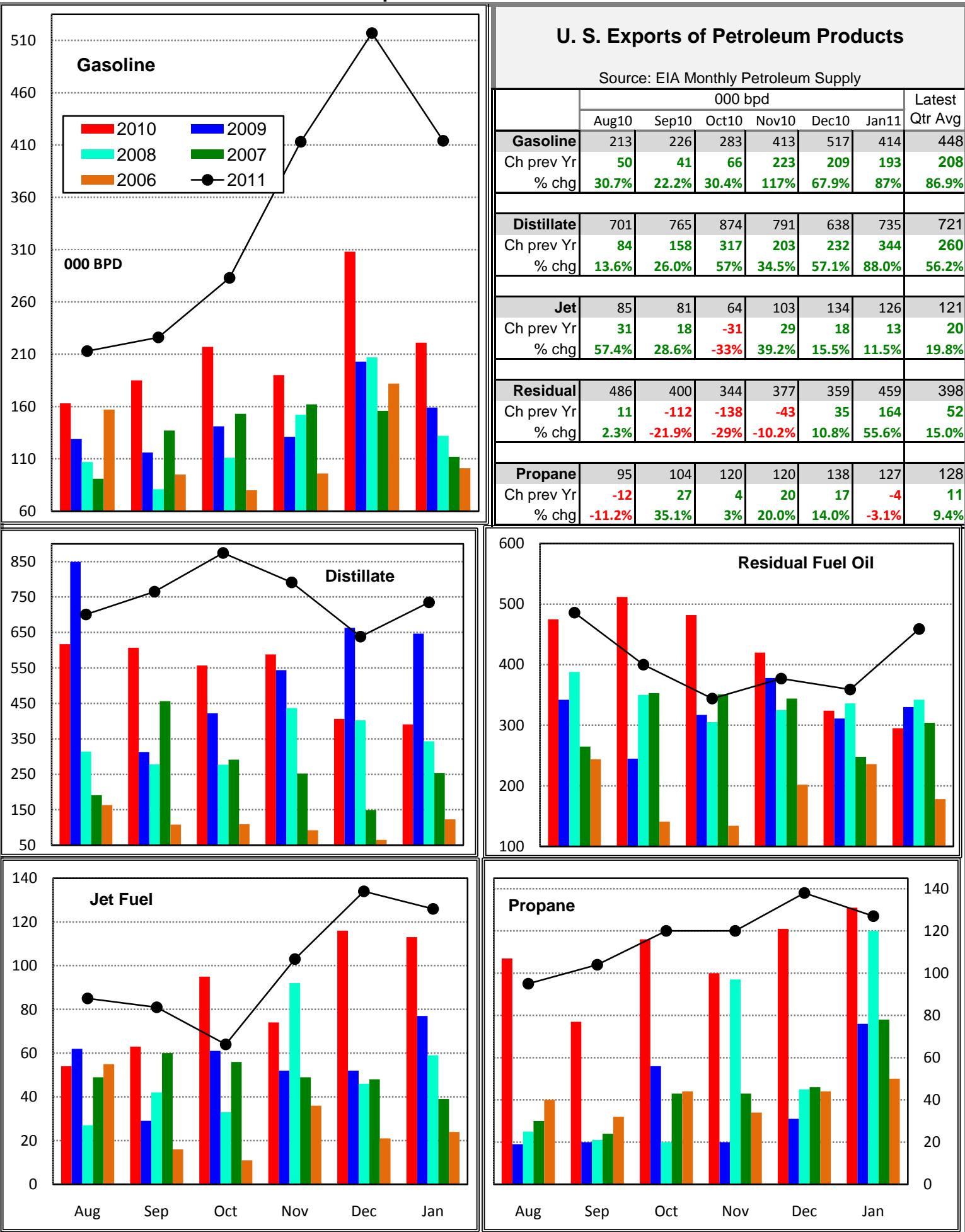
