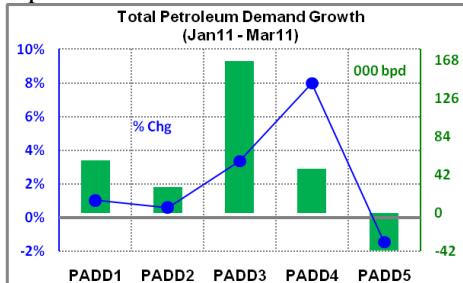

#### **Wholesale Petroleum Demand**

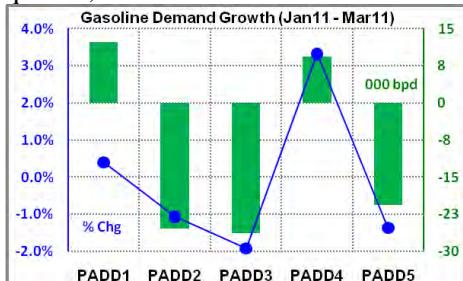
Wholesale demand for all petroleum products, including finished and unfinished products increased +260,000 bpd over the prior year for the January 2011 through March 2011 quarter, a +1.4% increase.

Distillate demand growth of +156,000 bpd the largest single fuel contributor to the growth in total petroleum demand for the quarter. Demand in PADDs 03 and 04 grew +3.3% and +8.0%; respectively. PADD 05 reported a -1.5% decrease.

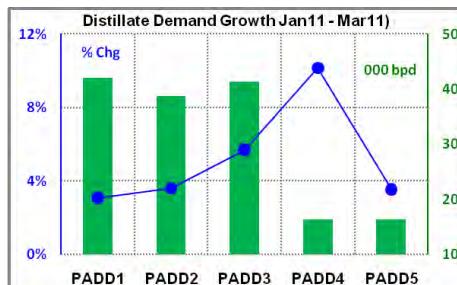


**Gasoline** wholesale demand decreased -51,000 bpd over the prior year for the January 2011 through March 2011 quarter, a -0.6% decrease.



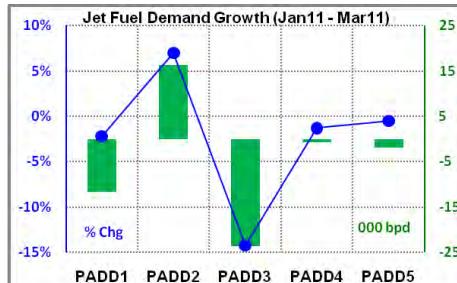
Demand was lower in PADDs 02, 03 and 05 with declines of -1.1%, -1.9%, and -1.4%; respectively. Demand increased less than +15,000 bpd in other regions.

**Distillate** wholesale demand increased +156,000 bpd over the prior year for the January 2011 through February 2011 quarter, a +4.1% increase.



Demand jumped +10.1% in PADD 04 and +5.7% in PADD 03 for the quarter. Demand in other regions increased +3.5%. Demand levels in PADDs 03 and 04 were comparable to pre recession levels, while the East and West Coast areas were sharply lower.

**Jet Fuel** wholesale demand decreased -22,000 bpd below the prior year for the January 2011 through February 2011, a -1.6% decrease.



Demand fell -24,000 bpd and -12,000 bpd in PADDs 03 and 01; respectively.

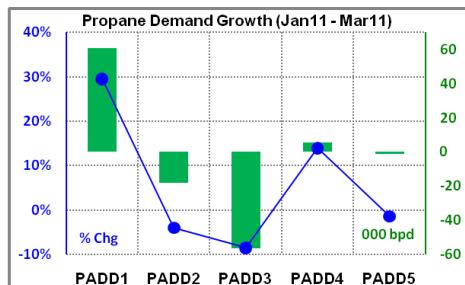
Demand increased +16,000 bpd in PADD 02.

**Residual fuel oil** wholesale demand increased +39,000 bpd over the prior year for the January 2011 through February 2011 quarter, a +7% increase.

Demand increased +52,000 bpd in PADD 03 and +12,000 bpd in PADD 02 for the quarter. Demand decreased -24,000 bpd in PADD 05.

**Propane** wholesale demand decreased -10,000 bpd over the prior year for the January 2011 through March 2011 quarter, a -0.7% decline.

After collapsing in October and November of 2010, demand rebounded to levels comparable to a year ago for the most recent 4-month period. Demand was down -57,000 bpd and -18,000 bpd in PADDs 03 and 02 for the quarter, compared to a year ago. Demand increased +61,000 bpd in PADD 01.

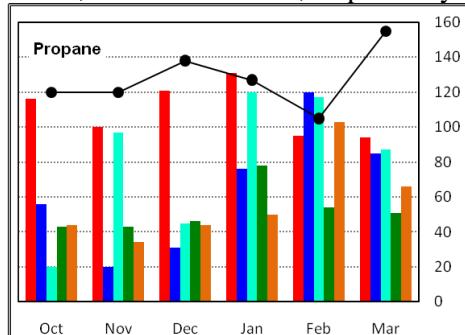


#### **Petroleum Product Exports**

Exports of refined fuels continued at a robust year on year pace, while propane spiked in March 2011.

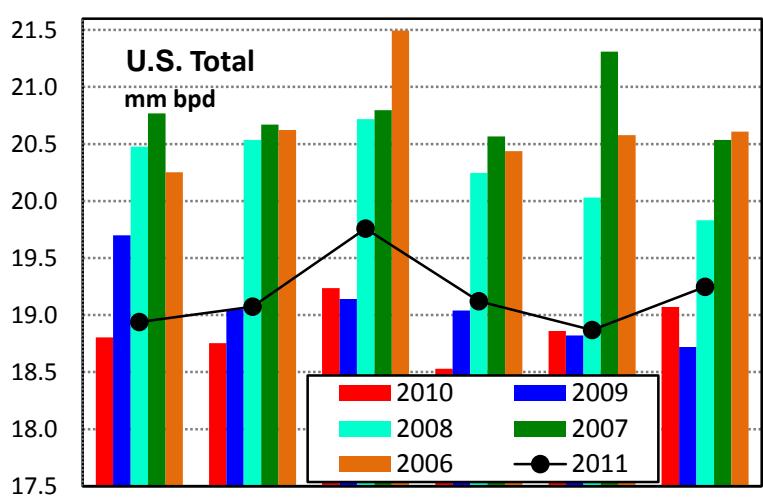

Gasoline exports averaged 419,000 bpd in the January 2011 through March 2011 quarter, a +50% year-on-year increase. Distillae exports averaged 684,000 bpd for the quarter, a +66% increase. Jet fuel, propane, and residual fuel oil exports increased +26%, +21% and +8.4%; respectively.



Combined exports of the 5-major fuels were +1.7 million bpd during the month of March 2011. This was a +270,000 bpd (+15%) increase over last year. The increase was down sharply from the nearly +0.5 million bpd in February. The lower growth was due in part to refinery maintenance during the period. The rise in exports reflects robust economic growth among Central and South American countries, and the closure of refineries in the Caribbean and Europe during the recession.

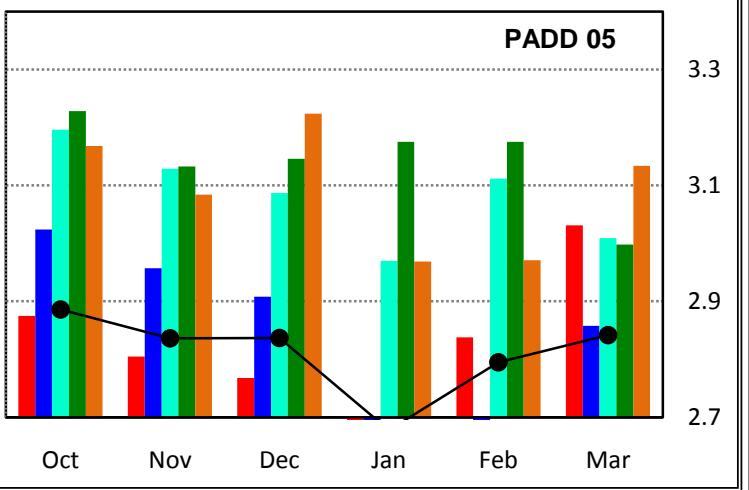
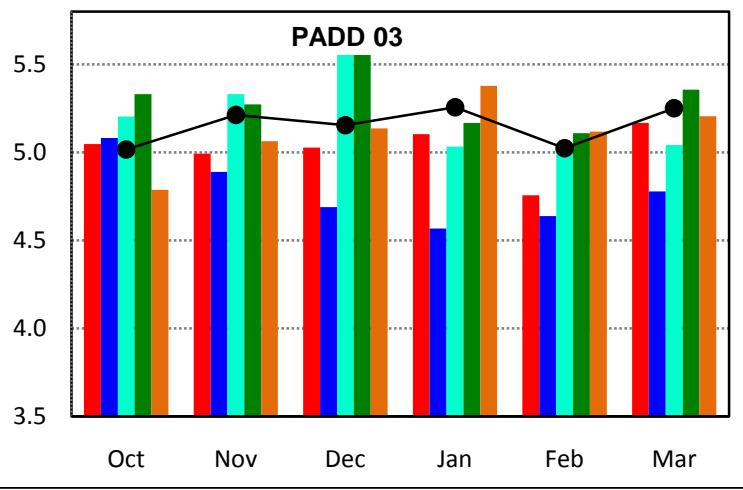
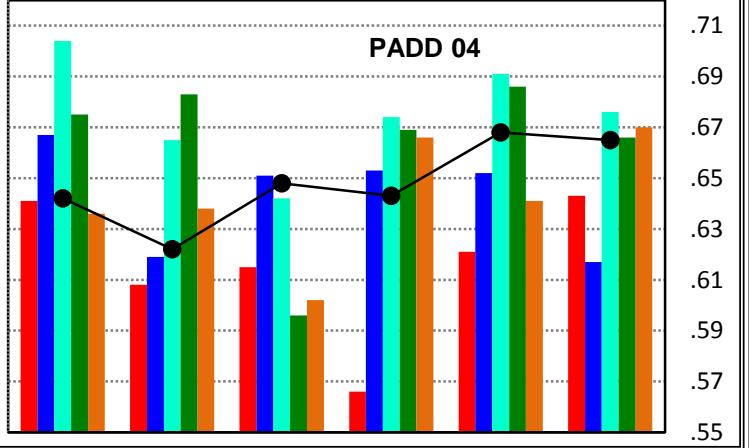
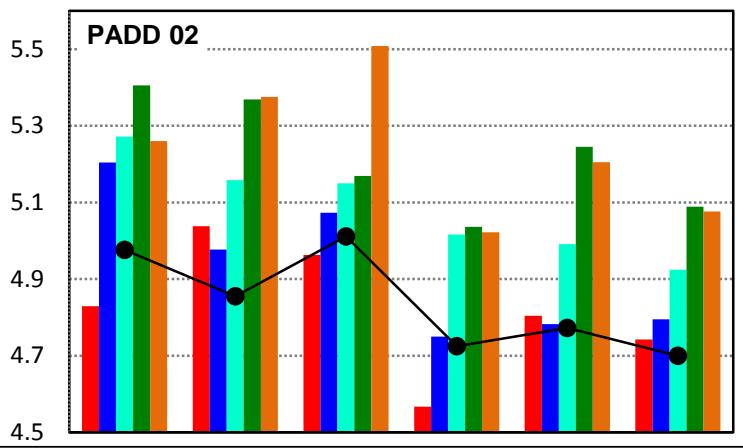
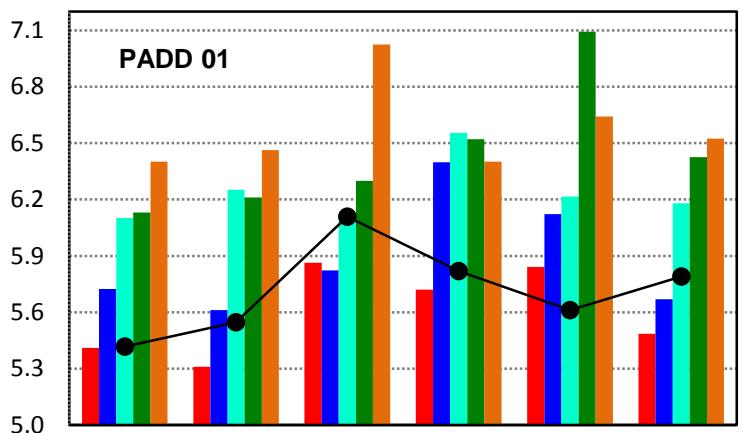
## Total Petroleum Demand



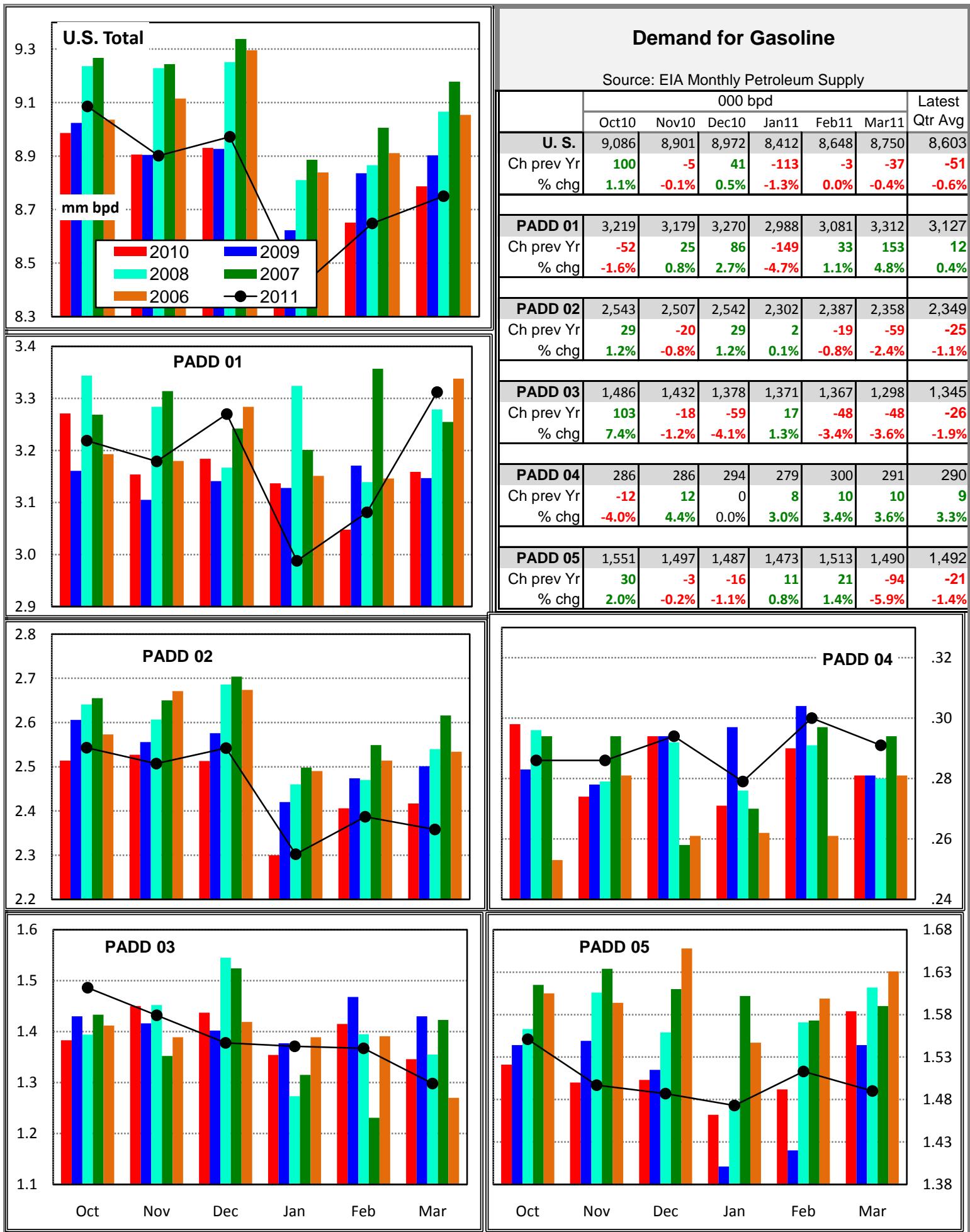
## Demand for all Petroleum Products

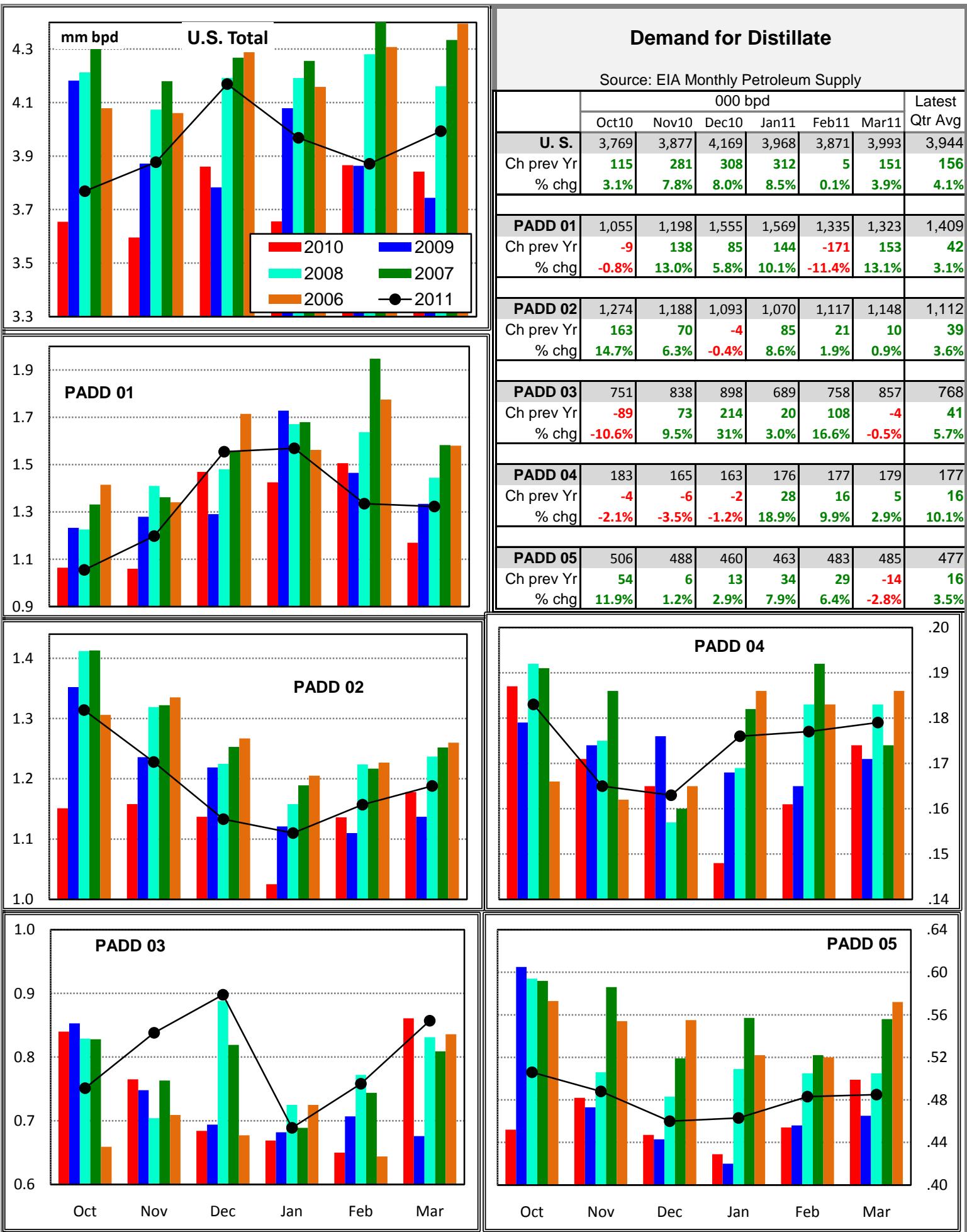

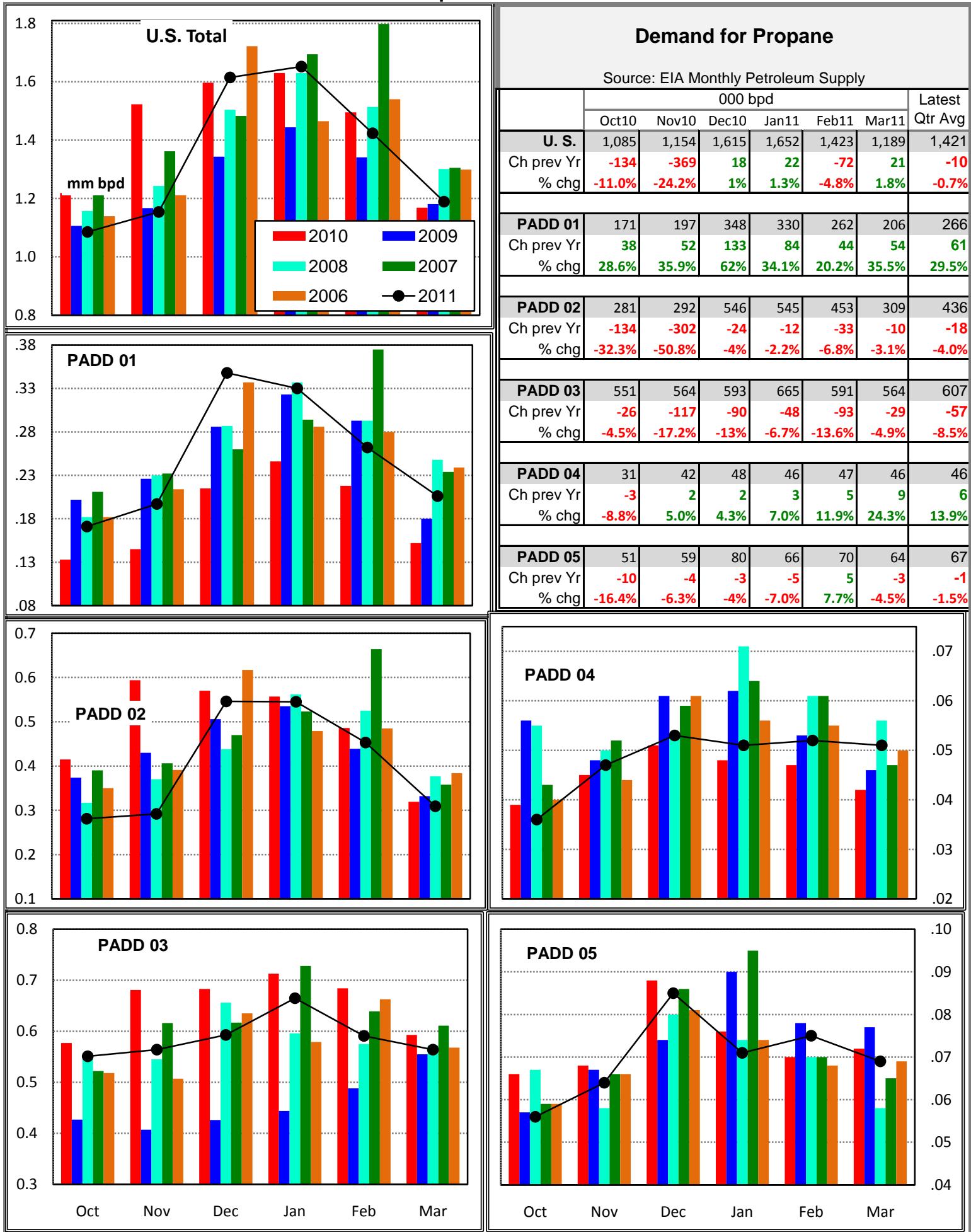
## Demand for Residual Fuel Oil
