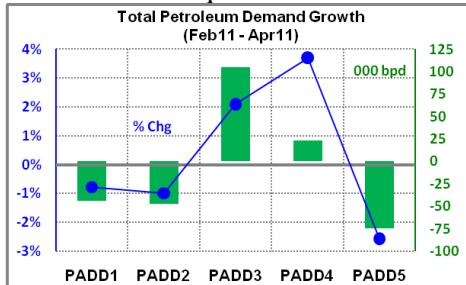
#### **Wholesale Petroleum Demand**

Wholesale demand for all petroleum products, including finished and unfinished products decreased -37,000 bpd compared to the prior year for the February 2011 through April 2011 quarter, a -0.2% decline.

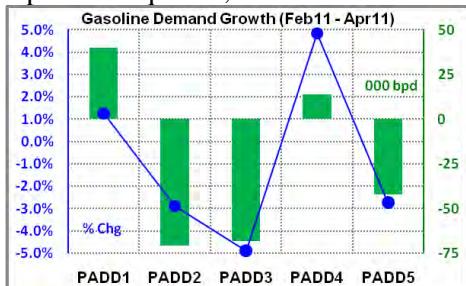

A gasoline demand decrease of -127,000 bpd was the largest contributor to the decline in total petroleum demand for the quarter. Demand decreased -2.6%, -1% and -0.8% in PADDs 5, 2 and 1, respectively. Demand increased +3.7% in PADD 4 and +2.1% in PADD 3 for the quarter.



Gasoline wholesale demand decreased -127,000 bpd compared to the prior year for the February 2011 through April 2011 quarter, a -1.4% decrease.



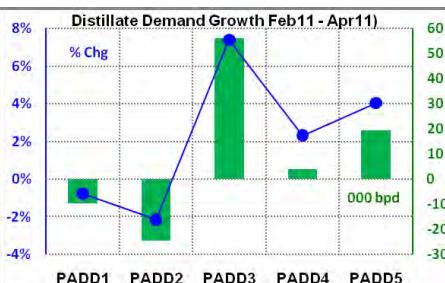
Demand was lower in PADDs 03, 02 and 05 with declines of -4.9%, -2.9%, and -2.7%; respectively. Demand increased +1.4% in PADD 1.

Distillate wholesale demand increased +46,000 bpd over the prior year for the February 2011 through April 2011 quarter, a +1.2% increase.

## MONTHLY PETROLEUM DEMAND-EXPORT TRENDS

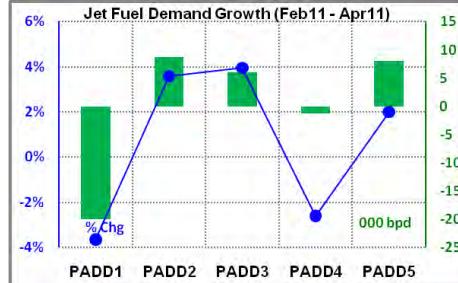
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Demand climbed +7.41% in PADD 03 and +4% in PADD 05 for the quarter. Demand was lower by -2.2% and -0.8% in PADDs 2 and 1, respectively. Demand in PADD 03 reached pre-recession levels, while regions remain below historic highs for this time of year.

Jet fuel wholesale demand was nearly unchanged for the quarter February 2011 through April 2011, compared to a year ago, with an increase of +1,000 bpd.



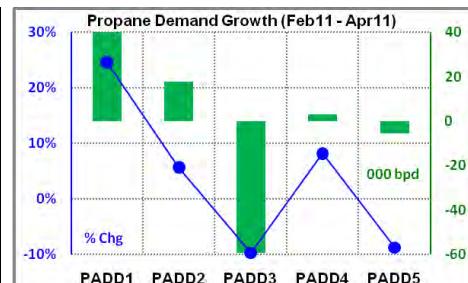
Demand increased +9,000 bpd and +8,000 bpd in PADDs 02 and 05, while decreasing -20,000 bpd in PADD 01.

Residual fuel oil wholesale demand increased +46,000 bpd over the prior year for the February 2011 through April 2011 quarter, a +8.4% increase.

Demand increased +74,000 bpd in PADD 03, while decreasing -29,000 bpd in PADD 01.

Propane wholesale demand decreased -4,000 bpd over the prior year for the February 2011 through April 2011 quarter, a -0.3% decline.

Demand fell -59,000 bpd in PADD 03 for the quarter. This was partially offset by an increase of +40,000 bpd and +18,000 bpd in PADDs 01 and 02; respectively. The PADD 01 jump represented a +25% rise in demand.

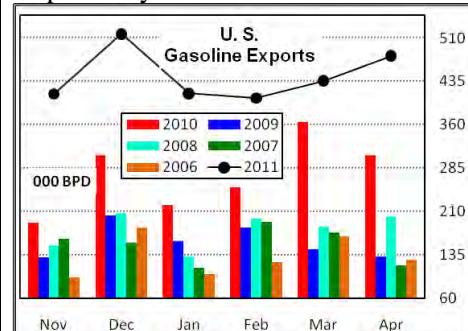


#### **Petroleum Product Exports**

Exports of refined fuels + propane exceeded 2.0 million bpd during April 2011.

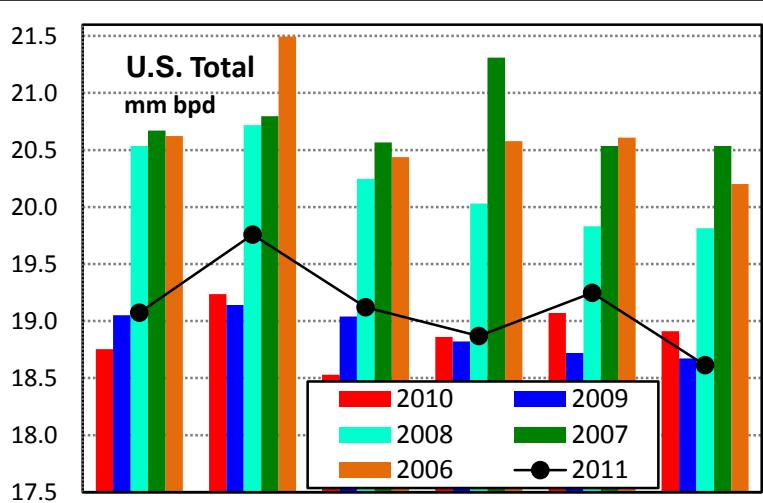
Gasoline exports averaged 440,000 bpd in the February 2011 through April 2011 quarter, a +43% year-on-year increase. Distillate exports averaged 730,000 bpd for the quarter, a +43% increase. Jet fuel and propane exports increased +37% and +54%; respectively.



The 2.0 million bpd of exports for the combined 5-major fuels during April 2011, exceeded last year by +459,000 bpd (+23%). The rise in exports reflects robust economic growth among Central and South American countries, and the closure of refineries in the Caribbean and Europe during the recession.

Exports of distillate were equal to 24% of domestic demand during April; propane equaled 19% while gasoline was 5.5%. Within the PADD 03 regional market, exports represent a significant share of production.

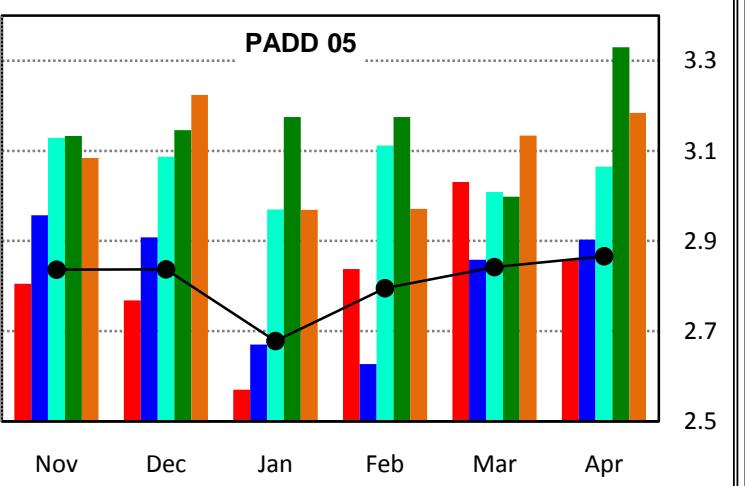
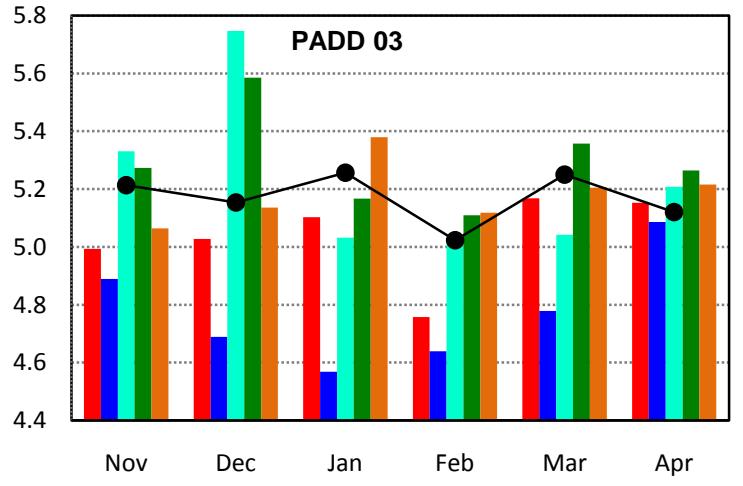
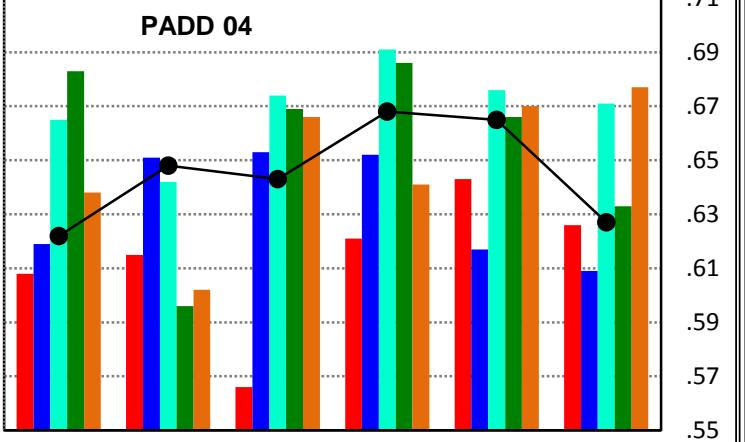
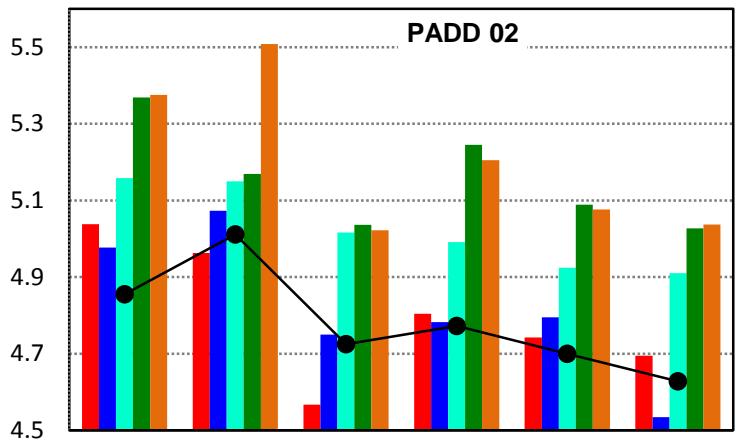
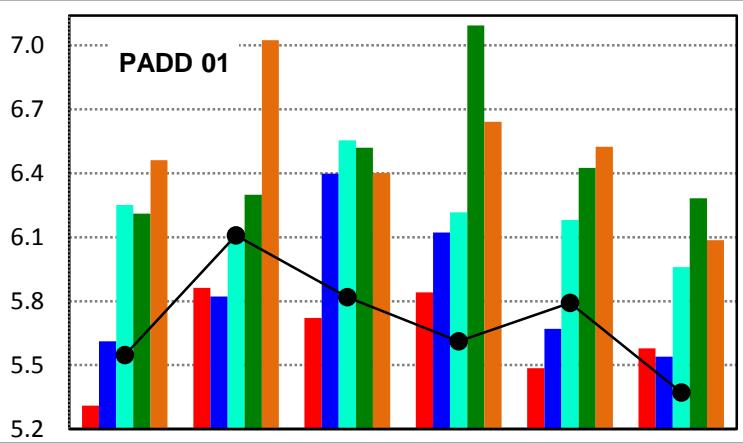
## Total Petroleum Demand



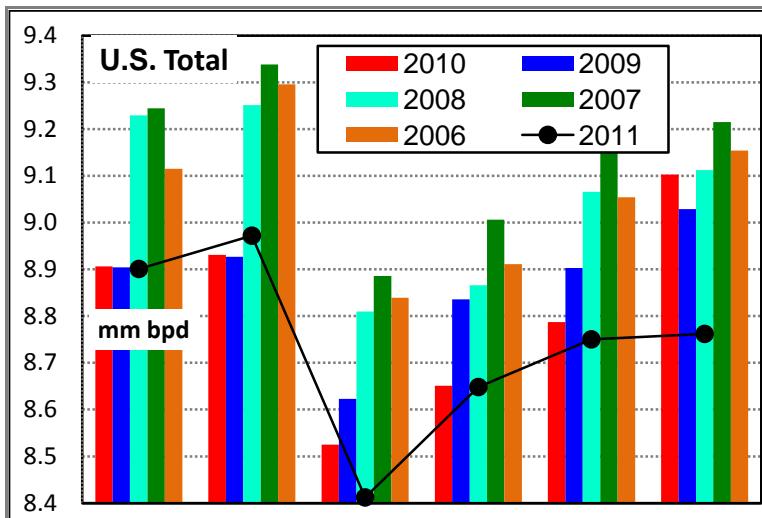
