





Summary ¹ The stock draw of -71Bcf last week was the third consecutive weekly record low draw, driving the 4-wk draw to well below the historic mid range. Stock levels ended the week above the 5-year mid range.



Heating degree days were -7% below normal for the week ending 05Mar11.



In the East Region stocks decreased -61 Bcf for the period, a draw that was less than the 5-year range. Stocks decreased -17 Bcf in the West Region, a record draw for the week. The stock build of +7 Bcf in the Producing Region was the 2nd consecutive weekly build compared to draws for this time of year in each of the last 5-years.

Heating degree days were -7% below normal in the East Region, +15% above normal in the West Region and -28% below normal in the Producing Region for the week ending 05Mar11.


National Weather Service 10-14 Day

Heating degree days were -7% below normal for the week ended 05Mar11, and forecast to be -5% below normal for the week ending 12Mar11.

The 6-10 day NWS forecast for the week ending 19Mar11 is for much warmer than normal across nearly the entire country.


The 8-14 day NWS forecast for the week ending 23Mar11 is for much warmer than normal temperatures across the eastern 2/3rds of the country.

Prices: Nearby gas futures prices were unchanged for the week ending 10Mar11. Prices levels remain near 5-year lows.



The 1st – 4th month forward price curve sideways last week 10Mar11. The spread ended the week at a record low carry, pointing to expectations of abundant supply in the future.

East Region stocks decreased -61 Bcf last week, a draw that was less than the 5-year range. The latest 4-wk draw was less than the 5-year mid range. Stock levels were at the low end of the historic range.




Heating degree days in the region were -7% below normal last week and are forecast to be -5% below normal for the week ending 12Mar11. Well below normal heating degree days are forecast for the next 10-days.


West Region stocks decreased -17 Bcf on

the week, a record draw for the week. Stock levels were well below the 5-year mid range. The latest 4-wk stock draw matched the record draw for this time of vear.

Heating degree days were +15% above normal last week, and forecast to be normal for the current week. Slightly below normal heating degree days are forecast for the next 10-days.



Producing Region stocks reported a build of +7 Bcf on the week, the 2nd consecutive weekly build, compared to draws in each of the last 5-years. The latest 4-wk stock draw was near the 5-year high. Stock levels were a record high for this time of vear.



Heating degree days were -28% below normal the prior week, and estimated to be -7% below normal for the week ending 12Mar11. Much warmer than normal temperatures are forecast for the next 10 davs.

Residual Fuel Oil Switching: The price spread between fuel oil and natural gas remains highly favorable for gas.

Outlook: Spring temperatures are forecast to arrive in the next 10-days. Stock builds have began in the key Producing Region 2wks ahead of the historic trend. Expect prices to remain weak for the next quarter.



NATURAL GAS: Graph Link and Weekly Summary








United States Natural Gas Stock and Weather Trends




Natural Gas East Region Stock and Weather Trends




Natural Gas West Region Stock and Weather Trends



Natural Gas Producing Region Stock and Weather Trends




U.S. Residual Fuel Oil Price Spreads and Supply Balance


